## **April 29, 2022 (65 day)**

During the war, Russia fired 1,300 missiles across Ukraine. The Russian military launched a missile strike on military facilities in the capital on the evening of April 28. As a result of enemy shelling in **Kyiv**, 10 people were injured and one died. At that time, **UN Secretary General** Antonio Guterres was on an official visit to Kyiv. 27 foreign diplomatic missions resumed work in Kyiv.

Also in the evening of April 28, an attack was made on an infrastructure facility in the Shepetivka district of **Khmelnytsky region** and on an infrastructure facility in Fastiv, **Kyiv region**. Another mass grave was found in Kyiv region.

In the **Zaporizhia region**, the Russian military is using the civilian population as a human shield and forcing the Russian ruble into circulation. According to the mayor of **Melitopol**, the Russian occupiers are kidnapping people at checkpoints and just on the streets.

**IAEA Director General** Rafal Grossi has condemned the sending of Russian military missiles over nuclear power plants in Ukraine, as such flights could lead to a nuclear accident. Both Ukrainian and Rosatom specialists brought from Russia are still at the **Zaporizhzhya NPP**. There is a danger due to partial occupation.

The OSCE has officially stated that it will close the work of the Special Monitoring Mission in Ukraine in the near future.

On the morning of April 29, Russian troops shelled the villages of Velyka Kostromka and Maryanske in the **Dnipropetrovsk region** using artillery systems `Grad`.

In **Mariupol**, the occupiers are distributing leaflets with information about life in the occupation and informing that all city residents must be filtered. The occupiers took ventilators out of Mariupol. Meanwhile, the Russian military continues to launch air strikes on Mariupol. Azovstal has 600 wounded servicemen, as well as civilians, who are being asked to use the "extraction" procedure and take them from Mariupol to Turkey.
