

3.4. Form of higher education applicants' certification

Certification is carried out in the form of a public defense of the qualifying work and a unified state qualification exam in the subject area according to the established order.

The qualifying work should not contain academic plagiarism, fabrication, or falsification.

The qualifying work must solve a complex task or problem in the field of public management and administration, which involves research and/or innovation and is characterized by uncertainty of conditions and requirements.

The qualifying work must be published on the official website or in the repository of the institution of higher education or its division.

The certification exam in the form of a unified state qualification exam must assess the compliance of learning outcomes with the requirements of the higher education standard and meet the organizational requirements for the unified state qualification exam, which are established by legislation.
