As of April 19, 2022, the **Office of the Prosecutor General** has documented 10,606 crimes: 7,280 war crimes and 3,326 crimes against Ukraine's national security. As a result of the Russian aggression, 205 children were killed and 367 were injured.

Today, the direct connection between the IAEA and the **Chornobyl** NPP was restored.

After the analysis of the rubble of houses in Borodyanka, **Kyiv region**, the bodies of 41 people were found under the rubble. In total, the bodies of 1,045 civilians have already been found in the Kyiv region.

It is reported that the Russian military forcibly relocated more than 500,000 people to Russia, including 121,000 children. Ukrainians are issued documents prohibiting them from leaving Russia for two years.

The situation in **eastern Ukraine** is difficult: the enemy is actively trying to advance and gain a foothold in occupied positions, increasing the number of troops.

Air strikes on the infrastructure of **Mariupol** continue, assaults are carried out near the seaport and the Azovstal plant. About 500 wounded Ukrainian soldiers remain there and about one thousand civilians are hiding.

In the cities of Popasna, Rubizhne and some others in the **Luhansk region**, electricity, gas and water supplies will not be restored until the end of the war. Tonight, the occupiers captured the western part of the town of **Rubizhne** and hoisted their flag at the entrance. 80% of the territory of Luhansk region is under Russian control.

It is also reported that there are plans to carry out forced mobilization in the temporarily occupied territories of **Zaporizhia and Kherson regions**.

In the evening, **Sumy region** was shelled from hail, and **Chernihiv region** - from mortars.
