## March 14, 2022

The Russian military continues to violate international humanitarian law, the laws and customs of war. They use indiscriminate weapons (phosphorous and cluster bombs), strike at civilian targets (schools, homes, hospitals, churches), use prohibited methods of war (hostage civilians, besiege towns and villages).

Throughout the day, the Russian military fired heavily on the administrative center of the **Luhansk region** - the city of Severodonetsk. School, houses, forestry were engaged.

As a result of intense night shelling in the **Kharkiv region**, residential neighborhoods, hospitals, infrastructure and industry were affected. A four-storey residential building was destroyed in the center of Kharkiv as a result of an air strike.

At least three civilians were killed in the night shelling of Okhtyrka in **Sumy region**.

Fifteen settlements in the **Donetsk region** (Mariupol, Volnovakha, Kramatorsk, Sviatohirsk) came under fire. At least 37 buildings were damaged, mostly by civilians. At least 2 people were killed. As a result of hostilities, the Karlivka filtering station was cut off, leaving 200,000 people without water supply in the cities of Pokrovsk, Bilytske, Myrnohrad, and others. The shelling of Avdiivka lasted all night. The Russian military uses Point-U and multiple rocket launchers. In Avdiivka, a coke plant, residential buildings, a gas pipeline and a school were damaged.

In the suburbs of **Kyiv** on the night of March 14, 2022, Russian troops launched artillery strikes on Irpen, Bucha and Gostomel. They continue to deploy equipment in settlements, which makes it difficult to strike back. In the morning, the shell hit a nine-story apartment building in Obolon (one person was killed and 10 were injured). A rocket strike was launched at the Antonov Aircraft Plant.

The city of **Mariupol** remains in a critical state, blocked, unable to deliver humanitarian aid. 2,500 civilians have already died in the city. The International Committee of the Red Cross called on the parties to the conflict to cease hostilities and provide an opportunity to evacuate the population and provide food and medical assistance.

On the night of March 14, the Russian military shelled **Chernihiv** and **Nizhyn**. The building of the National University "Chernihiv Polytechnic" was damaged. There are communication problems in Chernihiv, most of the city is without electricity (84,000 people). Nizhyn was shelled by Hurricanes.

In the **Zhytomyr region**, in the town of Stavyshche, civilian facilities and a communication tower were damaged. A TV tower near **Rivne** was damaged. Digital terrestrial broadcasting is temporarily unavailable. The communication tower in Stavyshche, **Kyiv** region, was also damaged.

On March 14, 2022, the power line to the **Chernobyl** nuclear power plant was damaged again, and it was repaired only the day before. The Russian military blew up part of the ammunition at the **Zaporizhzhya** NPP site near the training

center. There are 50 units of enemy equipment, 400 Russian military. These two dangerous objects are still under the control of the Russian military.

During the Russian aggression, 379 educational institutions in Ukraine were damaged. 90 children died and 100 were injured.
