The shelling of civilian objects and the blockade of large cities continue. As of February 24, 651 residential buildings in Ukraine have been completely destroyed and 3,780 have been partially damaged. We also pay special attention to the mining of suburbs and fields, which will lead to the unsuitability of a significant amount of fertile land.

Yesterday, March 21, evacuation buses with children from **Mariupol** came under fire. There are children in serious condition.

There has been no electricity, heat or water supply in **Chernihiv** for more than a week due to damage to critical infrastructure and active hostilities. The shelling of this city continues.

In **Kyiv**, as a result of the shelling in the morning, the shell hit a private house in the Sviatoshynskyi district. As a result of enemy shelling, a truck and two buildings caught fire in Obolon.

The Russian military fired artillery at the city of **Brovary** in the Kyiv region, a shell hit one of the factories, and 5 buses were damaged. Proceedings started under Art. 438 of the Criminal code of Ukraine upon violation of laws and customs of war. Iskander missiles struck a peaceful village on the outskirts of Brovary. Marauding continues in **Gostomel**. The occupiers looted shops, confiscated civilians' phones, clothes and food. In Makariv, the military changes into civilian clothes. The town of **Slavutych** is isolated.

The city of **Kherson** is on the verge of a humanitarian catastrophe. Food and medicine cannot be delivered due to the blockade. This situation is especially critical for newborns and the elderly. A similar situation is observed not only in the city, but throughout the region. In **Kherson**, people are protesting against the occupation, and the Russian military is using tear gas against them.

The city of **Mariupol** remains under siege. Today, Russian aircraft dropped two heavy bombs on the city. In addition to aircraft, it is shelled by jet artillery and ships.

A car was shot at from a tank in **Kharkiv** region, killing parents and a daughter. In Kharkiv, the occupiers bombed another school (school 134).

Russian troops struck from the "Hail" system in Zelenodolsk in the suburbs of **Kryvyi Rih**. Dwelling houses were destroyed.

In the **Chornobyl** Exclusion Zone, fires were recorded in seven cells, which could have been caused by a shell.

A supermarket in Severodonetsk, **Luhansk** region, where people were staying, was fired upon. Wholesale warehouses with food were destroyed. The day before, a fire was opened at the children's hospital.
