In **Kharkiv and Zaporizhia** oblasts, enemy troops are launching missile and bomb strikes on civilian infrastructure. In **Kharkiv**, night shelling continued, a large-scale fire broke out in one of the administrative buildings, killing 22 civilians and killing 7 people. More than 50 strikes were inflicted on Kharkiv Region in one day.

Tonight, the Russian military fired on a railway station in central Ukraine.

In the evening of April 12, 2022, enemy troops fired a missile at an infrastructure facility in Chudniv, **Zhytomyr region**, and at the infrastructure of Myrhorod, **Poltava region**.

In Borodyanka, **Kyiv region**, the territory is being demined, 8 destroyed high-rise buildings will have to be dismantled. The exhumation of the second part of the burial of the victims of the Russian military has begun in **Bucha**, according to preliminary estimates, the bodies of 65 people are there. The actions of the Russian military can be classified as crimes against humanity.

In the **Luhansk region** as a result of shelling of Lysychansk, Rubizhne, Severodonetsk 10 homes were damaged, one person died.

In the **Donetsk region** there are destructions of private houses, intensive shelling in Avdiivka, Marinka and Vugledar. One person was killed and three were injured. The situation in **Mariupol** is difficult, as the city has been under blockade since March 1, the city continues to be shelled. There has been no evacuation from the city for the last two days. In Mariupol, 13 mobile crematoria have been set up to free streets from the bodies of dead civilians. Seven people were injured in a missile strike by the Russian military on Cherkasovo in the **Donetsk region**.

In the **Kherson region**, more than 100 settlements that were temporarily occupied were left without electricity and water supply. Seven people were shot dead in the village of Pravdyne, and then a house with the dead was blown up.

More than 100 people have been reported killed in the **Sumy region**, and many civilian infrastructures have been destroyed.

In the morgue of **Dnipro** more than one and a half thousand dead Russian soldiers, whom the enemy is not going to take away.

As a result of the armed aggression of the Russian Federation, **191 children were killed** and more than 349 were injured.

Karim Khan, the chief prosecutor of the **International Criminal Court**, visited Bucha and stressed the need for an independent investigation.
