## April 25, 2022 (61 day)

Eight mayors of Ukrainian cities continue to be held captive by the Russian military. Today the heads of two communities of **Zaporizhia region** Ivan Senyk and Ivan Maleyev were released from captivity. We remind that in accordance with the provisions of international humanitarian law, combatants are taken prisoner, ie direct participants in the armed conflict who openly carry weapons and use them. Neither doctors, nor journalists, nor, moreover, the civilian population should be taken prisoner.

In the evening of April 24, 9 Russian missiles hit the infrastructure of Kremenchuk in **Poltava region**, including damage to the Kremenchug thermal power plant (the city is now without hot water) and the Kremenchug refinery, killing one person and injuring seven.

Five civilians were killed and five others were injured in Russian shelling in **Donetsk region** on Sunday. The city of **Mariupol** remains under blockade for 56 days. In Mangush, according to a photo of plaques on mass graves, the burial of 9,000 Mariupol residents is estimated. 200 meters long trenches have appeared 5 km from Mariupol in the village of Stary Krym.

In the **Kharkiv region**, the equipment of one of the plants was exported to Russia, and a torture chamber was set up in its premises. For the previous day, April 24, 2 people died and 11 were injured. On April 25, Russian civilians killed three civilians in Dergachi.

A fire broke out in two settlements in Zolochiv district of Lviv region.

In the **Luhansk region**, three high-rise buildings and four private houses burned down due to Russian shelling. The enemy hit the Lysychansk refinery for the third time.

In the **Mykolaiv region** because of attack of the village of Shevchenkove there was a fire of private buildings.

Today there were 5 shellings of railway stations in the central and western part of Ukraine. The Krasne station in the **Lviv region** was damaged. The rocket fire damaged the railway infrastructure of the town of Zdolbuniv, **Rivne region**, as well as 20 nearby houses, one person was injured. The shelling of the railway infrastructure of Zhmerynka and Kozyatyn in **Vinnytsia region** killed 5 people and injured 18.

According to the Prosecutor General of Ukraine, **3,818 civilians were killed** and more than 4,000 were injured in the Russian aggression.
