

March 25, 2022 (day 30)

In the north and south of Ukraine, the enemy is distributing propaganda leaflets in the temporarily occupied areas. Leaders of local self-government are disappearing in the occupied territories.

In the evening of March 24, the Kyiv-Ivano-Frankivsk evacuation train came under fire near Vasylkiv, not far from **Kyiv**. In the evening of March 24, heavy artillery also fired on a residential area on the outskirts of Vyshhorod, damaging a high-rise building. On the evening of March 24, the military also fired munitions into an oil depot, leading to a fire. 75 civilians have already died in the capital.

Night shelling of **Kharkiv** (54 times) killed 6 people and injured 17. The terminal of the Kharkiv airport, as well as the Metro supermarket were fired upon. The building of the Faculty of Economics of Karazin Kharkiv National University was destroyed. The Russian military fired from multiple rocket launchers at the city clinic, which houses a humanitarian aid center (four people were killed and three others were injured). Dergachi near Kharkiv was shelled: living quarters, a hospital, an ambulance. In total, 300 civilians have already died in the Kharkiv region, 15 of them children.

As a result of the bombing of the **Mariupol** Drama Theater by a Russian plane on March 16, about 300 people died. Residents are left without food, and the enemy blocks the humanitarian operation.

In the **Kyiv region**, shelling continues in the north, including the villages of Novi Petrivtsi and Stari Petrivtsi. The town of **Slavutych** remains surrounded by the Russian military. Snipers work in the city, it is forbidden to move through the city streets.

The situation in **Chernihiv** remains difficult. The city is under siege.

Five people were killed and eight were injured in the **Luhansk region** of Severodonetsk and Rubezhnoye. 32 houses were damaged.
