The situation in the Russian-occupied territories is temporarily difficult. The civilian population is deprived of motor vehicles and civilian clothes, and military and civil servants are wanted.

During the day, the Russian military carried out 24 shellings in **Luhansk region**, which killed two people and wounded two people. 225 people were evacuated from the region. The Russian military uses school buildings and surrounding areas to house equipment, weapons and ammunition.

Novosilka, Vuhledar, Kramatorsk, and Bakhmut are being intensively shelled in the **Donetsk region**. Three people were killed and seven were injured. **Mariupol** has been under blockade since March 1. 95% of buildings in the city were destroyed. Residents of the city report the exhumation of bodies buried in the yards of residential buildings. The destroyed universities in Mariupol will continue their work in Kyiv and Dnipro.

Border settlements in Sumy and Chernihiv regions came under fire.

Kharkiv is under partial blockade, the city is under artillery fire. A total of 2,055 buildings were destroyed in the city. As a result of the shelling of civilian buses by the Russian military near the village of Borova, Izium district, **Kharkiv region**, seven people were killed and 27 were injured. Such actions violate the provisions of paragraph 2 of Art. 51 of Additional Protocol (I) to the **Geneva Conventions** of 1949, according to which "*civilians as such, as well as individual civilians, shall not be the object of attacks. Acts of violence or threats of violence with the main purpose of terrorizing the civilian population are prohibited.*"

In the **Kherson region**, the temporarily occupied settlements are on the verge of a humanitarian crisis. The Russian military is looting. In **Oleshky**, the Russian military hung its flag on the administration building.

Another official exchange took place today: 22 Ukrainian servicemen and 8 civilians returned home.

Ukrainians filed 76,700 applications for destruction and damage to property.

Speakers from the Senates of **Poland and the Czech Republic**, who were released in **Kyiv region**, visited Irpin, Bucha and Borodyanka.
