In **Lviv**, as a result of 4 rocket attacks, civilian infrastructure was damaged, 40 cars were damaged or destroyed, and seven people were killed and eleven wounded.

In **Kramatorsk** there was a rocket attack on residential areas of the city.

The Russian military shot dead civilians leaving Kreminna, killing four people.

Kharkiv has been hit hard during the last 5 days. A humanitarian aid station was shelled today, one person was killed and six were injured. As a result of the shelling of the Osnovyansky district of Kharkiv, shells fell on the playground, killing a man and a woman.

In **Mariupol**, the number of civilians killed is 22,000. According to the UN, more than 100,000 civilians in the city are suffering from food and water shortages. The Russian military, which controls access to the city, did not allow representatives of the **UN World Food Program**. There are filtration camps on the outskirts of the city, to which people are taken before deportation to Russia, and at least 27,000 people are reported to be detained.

In **Mykolaiv** people collect rainwater and water from the river, after all because of attacks the city for almost a week without water supply.

In accordance with the provisions of Art. 48 of Additional Protocol (I) to the **Geneva Conventions** of 1949 stipulates that "*in order to ensure respect for and protection of civilians and civilian objects, the parties to the conflict must always distinguish between civilians and combatants, as well as civilian and military projects and accordingly direct their actions only against military facilities.*"
