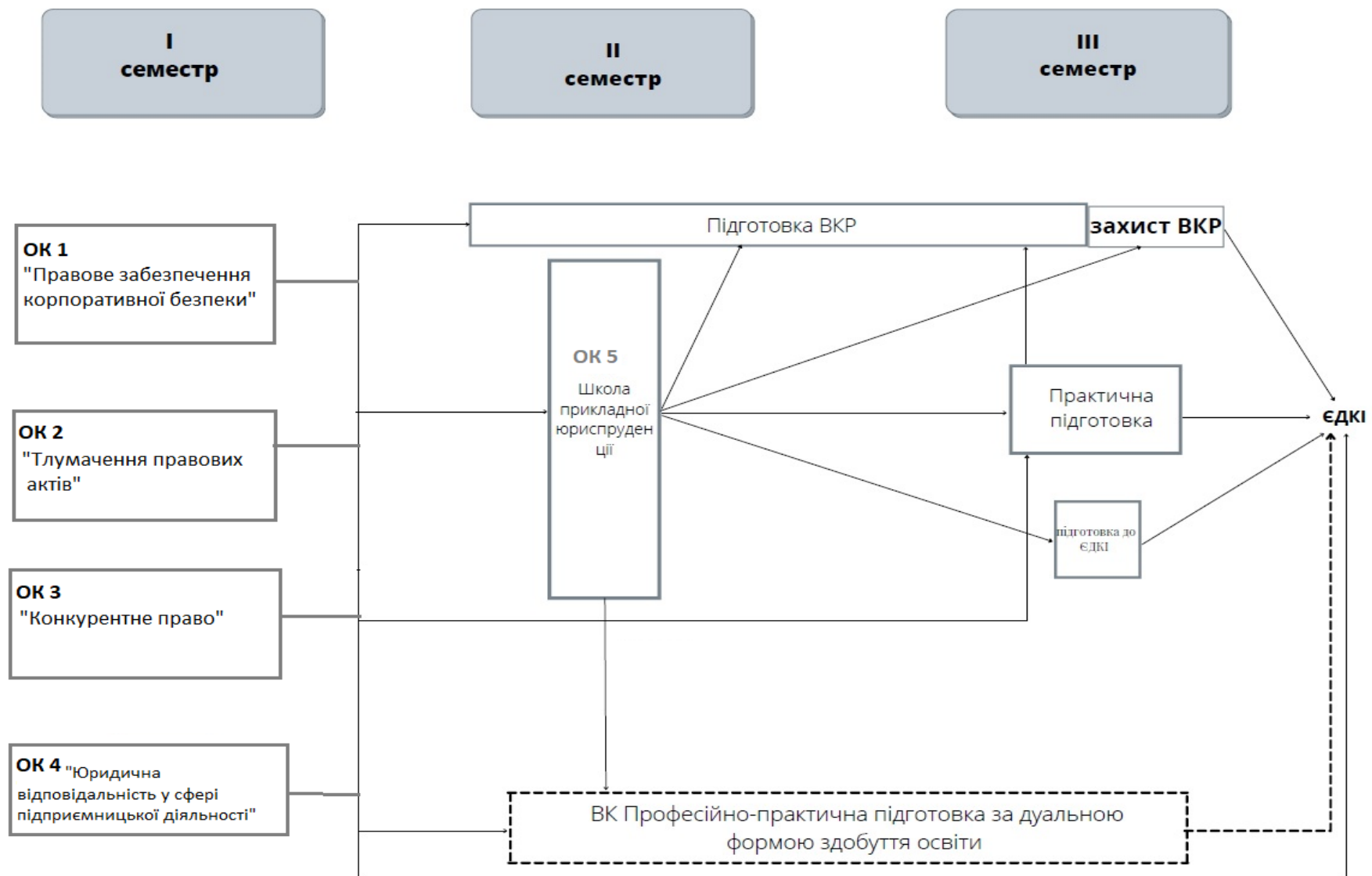

3. Form of certification of applicants for higher education

Certification of applicants for the second (master's) level of higher education in the specialty 081 "Law" is carried out in the form of:

- unified state qualification examination (examinations) in accordance with the procedure established by the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine;
- public defense of the final qualification work.

The final qualification work should include the solution of research and / or innovation problems in the field of lawmaking and law enforcement or other issues in the field of law.

The final qualifying work should not contain academic plagiarism, fabrication and falsification.

The final qualifying work must be published on the official website of the higher education institution or its subdivision, or in the repository of the higher education institution.

Publication of final qualifying works containing information with limited access is carried out in accordance with the requirements of current legislation.

Upon successful certification of the student is issued a standard document on awarding him a master's degree with a qualification: higher education master's degree in "Law" specialization "Legal Support For Entrepreneurship Security".
