8-Resource support for program implementation

Academic staff The staff of teachers involved in the implementation of the OPP, meets the staffing requirements for educational activities in higher education, provided by the License Conditions for educational activities of educational institutions (Cabinet of Ministers Resolution №1187 of 30.12.2015). 
