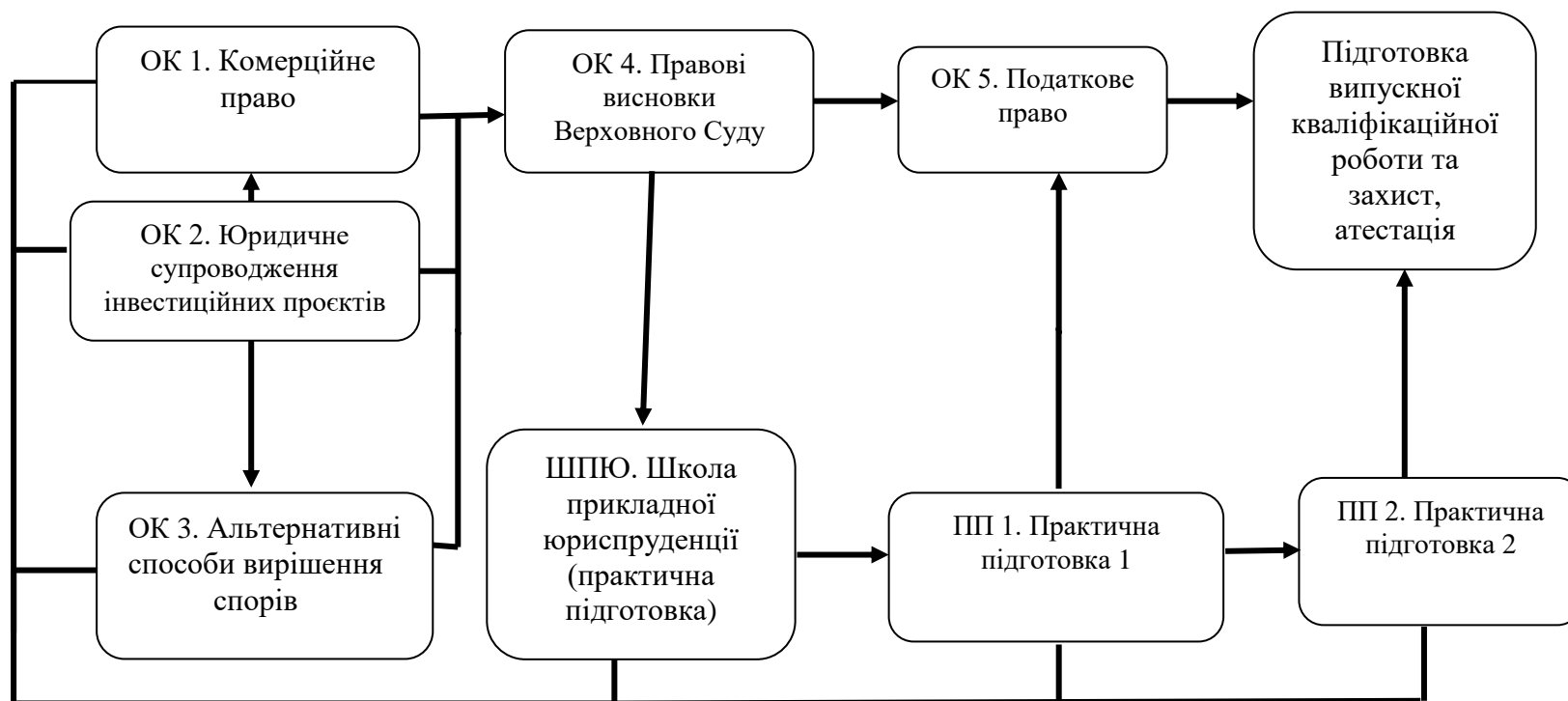

3.3. Final assessment

Final assessment of the second (master) graduate's level of higher education in specialty 081 "Law" is carried out in the form of:

- Complex qualifying examination in accordance with the procedure established by the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine;
- public defence of the Master's Thesis.

The final qualifying paper is aimed at solving a specific and / or practical problem in the field of law, which involves research and / or innovation.

The final qualification paper shall not contain academic plagiarism, fabrication and / or falsification.

The final qualification paper should be made public on the website of the higher education institution / its subdivision or in the repository of the higher education institution.

The publications of final qualification papers that contain information with limited access are carried out in accordance with the requirements of current legislation.

If a student passes the certification successfully, he/she is issued a standard document on awarding him/her a master's degree with the qualification: degree of higher education (Master's degree) in specialty "Law" specialization "Commercial Law".
