Program description for students of KNUTE

Program: Double degree program «Bachelor degree in economy and management».

Academic degree: Licence.

Duration: 1 year.

Mode of study: distance course (for students, who study in French there is a possibility to study the 2nd semester in UGA).

Language: French or English.

Admission requirements:

- 3 years of study at KNUTE.
- Minimum requirement English or French B1.

Registration:

- preliminary registration will be during May June ;
- the list of candidates sent to UGA during September;
- to the candidates will be open an access for a previous registration on the UGA web site, where they have to full fill the document «Dossier of equivalence»;
- the Faculty of economics of UGA is given an official «Document about an individual admission», which allows an administrative record to the university;
- candidates have to full fill a document «Administrative dossier», then send it to UGA and pay the tuition fee before November 1st.

After this students will receive an access to the pedagogical resources on the multimedia platform of the Faculty of economics of UGA.

Terms after which French speaking students can receive a degree:

- 1. to get minimum 10 scores in 20 after the exams;
- 2. to get Bachelor degree at KNUTE;
- 3. to give DELF / DALF B2.

Terms after which English speaking students can receive a degree:

- 1. to get minimum 10 scores in 20 after the exams;
- 2. to get Bachelor degree at KNUTE;
- 3. to get a credit for a French course;
- 4. to give Toefl / IELTS B2.
